ST JAMES PARK: THE HOME OF THE GRECIANS

Exeter City's St James Park stadium is conveniently located in the heart of the city of Exeter.

The club was founded in 1901 and was the first team to play the Brazil national team in 1914. The club has been owned by the Supporters' Trust since 2003 and has since gone from strength to strength. Exeter City is nationally renowned for its Academy which has produced Premier League and International stars Ollie Watkins and Ethan Ampadu, as well as providing players for the first-team.

St James Park has been the Grecians home since 1901. The stadium's capacity is roughly 8,500. St James Park consists of four stands, with the heart of the support in the Thatchers Big Bank, the largest standing terrace in the Football League. The Nevada Construction Main Stand is an all-seated standing housing 2,100 supporters, running the length of the pitch, it offers a great view of the action at both ends of the ground. In 2018 the Optimising IT Adam Stansfield Stand opened, which houses 1600 supporters and remembers Grecian legend Adam Stansfield.

Away fans are housed in the covered Tracks Suzuki St James Road Terrace which houses 1,000 supporters. 350 seats are also available in the Selco Builders Warehouse Main Stand.

VISITING BY TRAIN

The closest station is Exeter St James station which is conveniently located right outside of the stadium at: Well Street, Exeter EX4 6PX

VISITING BY CAR

From the M5: Exit westbound at Junction 29 onto the A3015 (Honiton Road). Follow the road onto the B3183 (Heavitree Road) for two miles, going past Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital. Take the fourth exit at the roundabout into Western Way, and at the next roundabout take the second exit onto Old Tiverton Road. St James Park and Stadium Way are located on the left.

From the East: Follow the A303/A30 towards Exeter, passing under the M5 bridge, at Junction 29. Then follow the above instructions from the M5.

From the West: Follow signposts towards Exeter centre. After crossing the River Exe near Exeter St Thomas rail station, join the A3015 (Frog Street). Follow the one-way system and then exit onto the B3212 (Magdalen Street) and follow the road as it veers left towards the roundabout. Take the third exit at the roundabout into Western Way, and at the next roundabout take the second exit onto Old Tiverton Road. St James Park and Stadium Way are located on your left.

PARKING

Please note that there is no on-site parking for supporters at St James Park on matchdays. There is also very limited residential parking available locally.

Exeter Bus Station is located around 10 minutes walk from St James Park.

THE TICKET OFFICE

The Exeter City ticket office has a welcoming and helpful team to assist with all ticketing related enquiries, for both home and away supporters.

Monday to Friday, 10am to 4pm the ticket office is based in our club shop.

On match days, to buy or collect tickets home supporters should head to the Ticket Booth in the Fan Zone which is open from 12pm to 5.30pm (closed during the match). Away supporters have their own dedicated booth situated on St James Road, which is open from 1.30pm to 3pm

Ticket prices increase on matchdays, so we recommend booking early to save time and money.

THE CLUB SHOP

The club shop offers a wide range of official Exeter City merchandise including replica shirts, training wear, hats, scarves, gifts, souvenirs, programmes, books and much more.

The club shop is situated within the stadium and is joined with reception.

THE CENTRE SPOT BAR

THE JUNIOR GRECIANS LOUNGE

The Junior Grecians Family Zone is open on most matchdays, and available for use by all family visitors to St James Park.

The zone is open to all from 12:30pm for members, and 1:30pm for all visitors! The room provides a safe comfortable environment for families to enjoy pre-match entertainment, such as a large screen TVs, Playstation consoles and Table Football, as well as the option to enjoy refreshments from the Zone's very own kiosk.

A feature wall displaying a packed Big Bank also provides a photo-sharing opportunity using the #jgzzone hashtag. There are activities and competitions to suit all junior age groups, from FIFA23 and Table Football tournaments to free Activity Packs for younger children.

ACCESSIBILITY INFO

PARKING AND ACCESS

Accessible parking is very limited, (supporters are advised to contact club reception for availability). Access is through the accessible gate to the Big Bank Stand via Stadium Way, it is fairly level and ramps are in use within the Stadium.

PLACES AND POSITIONS

Wheelchair users (designated areas)

8 Away Supporters: 1 area in Main Stand, 1 area in St James Road Stand.

DEDICATED COMMENTARY SERVICE

10 headsets available for Home & Away supporters. Supporters wishing to use the service are advised to contact club reception on 01392 411243 to reserve a headset.

DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING

Unlimited places. On request, a Portable Induction Loop is available for use in the club shop and reception.

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Assistance dogs are admitted to the ground. The Club's Stadium Manager or Disability Liaison Officer should be contacted in advance for all relevant information.

WHEELCHAIR FOR HIRE

The club has two wheelchairs available for hire on match days for those supporters who have a need of a wheelchair because of a temporary disablement. Anyone requiring the use of one of these chairs are advised to contact club on: 01392 411243.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS AND CATERING

Can be found in the Centre Spot; Trust Suite, Heritage Suite, Optimising IT Adam Stansfield Stand, Big Bank, Junior Grecian Zone – key behind bars/kiosk. Catering Facilities are available but not dedicated.

Disabled Parking

Disabled parking is limited and should be booked in advance to avoid disappointment. These are allocated to supporters with the most severe mobility difficulties. People attending the wheelchair areas of the stadium are given priority for the available places. However people with other mobility difficulties can make requests for any remaining places.

Exeter Bus Station

is located around ten minutes' walk from St James Park. It is the terminus for many local buses in the Exeter area, as well as serving intercity coach companies including Megabus, National Express, First Bus and Western Greyhound.

Evening Matchdays By Car

Please note that there is no on-site parking for supporters at St James Park on matchdays.

By Rail:

The stadium is served by St James Park rail station, a few minutes' walk from the ground. The station lies on the Avocet Line (First Great Western trains), which runs from Exeter St David's to Exmouth, also calling at Exeter Central. The Exeter St David's and Exeter Central stations connect the city to the other major cities across the UK.

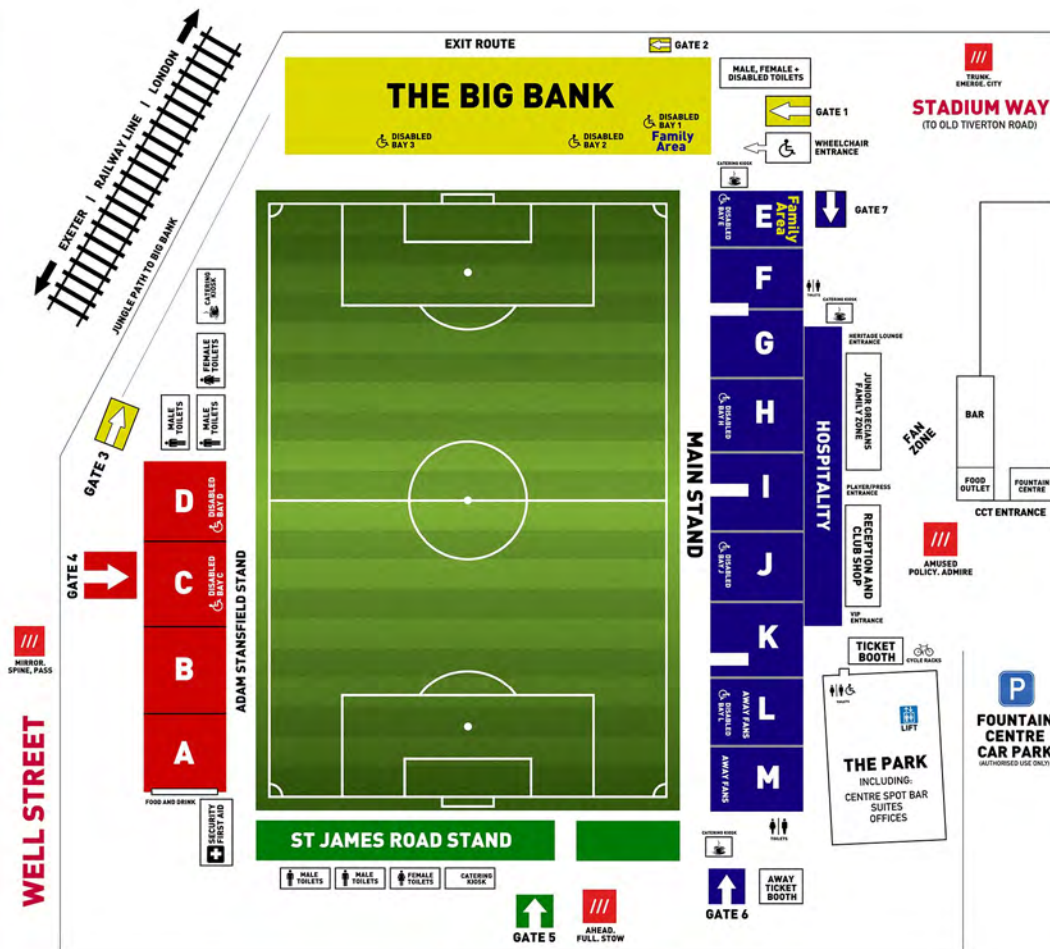
